

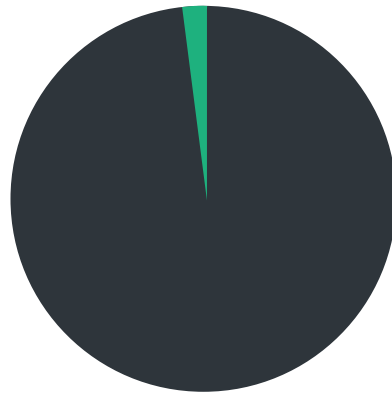


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF, EKAM FOUNDATION CHATTISGARH, JANUARY -18

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Under PCA(Program Cooperation Agreement), as many as 18 Sick Newborn Care Units became functional across 17 districts (Raipur, Drug, Dhamtari, Bilaspur, Rajnandgaon, Ambikapur, Jagdalpur, Koriya, Korba, Raigarh, Kanker, Dantewada, Jashpur, Mahasamund and Kawardha, Balod and JanjgirChampa) providing 24/7 care delivery to the infants.
- A total of 197 staff nurses, 15 Doctors and 16 DEOs were placed across these 18 SNCUs.
- In all, 868 equipments were inventoried within the 14 SNCUs and are being put under the Annual Maintenance Contract.
- All the SNCUs were provided with the central helpline phone number in order to ensure timely repairs. During this month 59 preventive visits have been done by engineers in SNCUs and FRUs.
- Total 7 breakdown calls were registered from different districts.
- In the reporting month 102 blood samples were collected from SNCUs.
- The Observership training was facilitated in January.
- 7 new doctors were recruited.
- Total 183 cold calls were made to staff nurses through helpline number

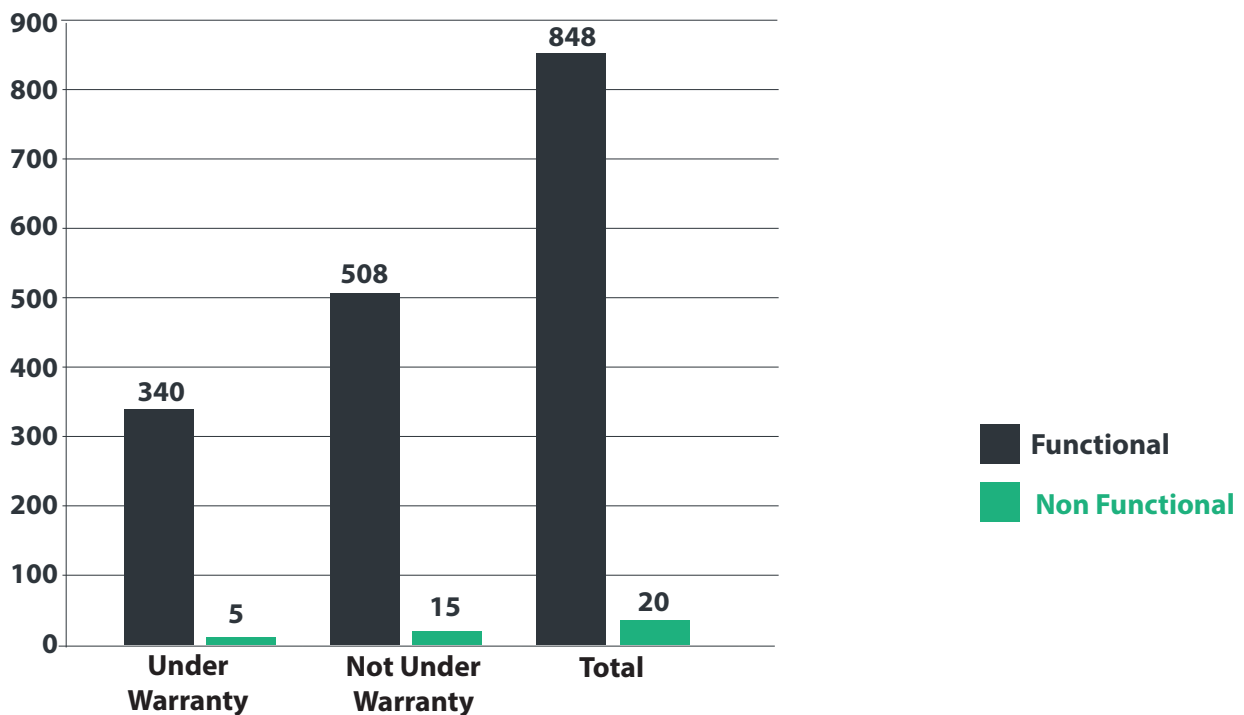

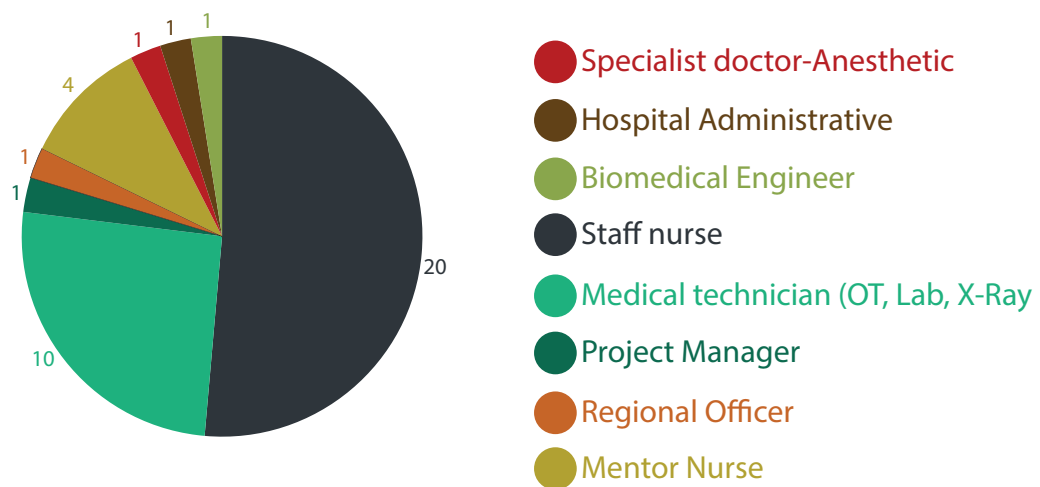

• MENTOR NURSE TRAINING:

The purpose of this training was to impart knowledge and skills to empower Mentor Nurses on Obstetrics, Neonatal & Pediatric Care skills over a period of 18 days. Mentor nurses were imparted knowledge & skill based training on 4 aspects of care i.e.,

1. SKILL (Dakshata) Maternal and Newborn Health, Antenatal Care, AMTSL (Active Management of Third Stage of Labor), PPH (Post Partum Hemorrhage), Eclampsia and Family Planning Methods)
2. NSSK (Navjat Shishu Suraksha Karyakram)
3. IYCF (Infant and Young Child Feeding), Advantage of Breast feeding for Mother and Infant, Benefits of colostrums, etc
4. Immunization (Basic Schedule of Vaccination)

• EQUIPMENT MAINTAINENCE:

In all, 366 equipments were inventoried and audited within the 15 units including District hospital, CHC and PHC. 278 (76%) equipments were functional. A breakup of the total number of equipment unit wise is given below:
