

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY, EKAM FOUNDATION CHHATTISGARH

DECEMBER 2017

HIGHLIGHTS - QUALITATIVE REPORT

1. According to PCA(Program Cooperation Agreement) 18 Sick Newborn Care Units were supposed to be functional in the year 2016-17, however only 16 SNCUs were functional across 16 districts (Raipur, Durg, Dhamtari, Bilaspur, Rajnandgaon, Ambikapur, Jagdalpur, Koriya, Korba, Raigarh, Kanker, Dantewada, Jashpur, Mahasamund Kawardha, Bijapur and Balod) providing 24/7 care delivery to the infants till Dec,16. All functional SNCUs have adequate number of trained staff nurses and Data entry operators (DEO).

2. A total of 195 staff nurses, 8 Doctors and 16 DEOs were placed across these 18 SNCUs.

3. In all, 780 equipments were inventoried within the 13 SNCUs. 382 (49%) equipments were covered under the Annual Maintenance Contract or were still under warranty while around 51% of the equipments (400 equipments) were not under warranty. On an average, 96 % of the equipments were functioning. While only 4% of both, the non warranty and warranty equipments were not functional. All the SNCUs were provided with the central helpline phone number in order to ensure timely repairs. During this month 51 preventive visits have been done by Engineers in SNCUs and FRUs.

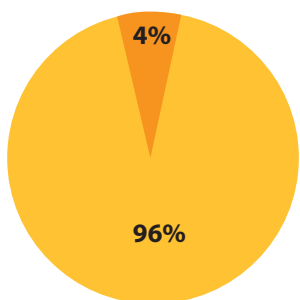


4. Total 6 breakdown calls were registered from different districts namely (Ambikapur, Raigarh, Bilaspur, jagdalpur and Mahasamund) during the reporting period. Except one all equipments were out of warranty.



5. In the reporting month 45 blood samples were collected from SNCUs.

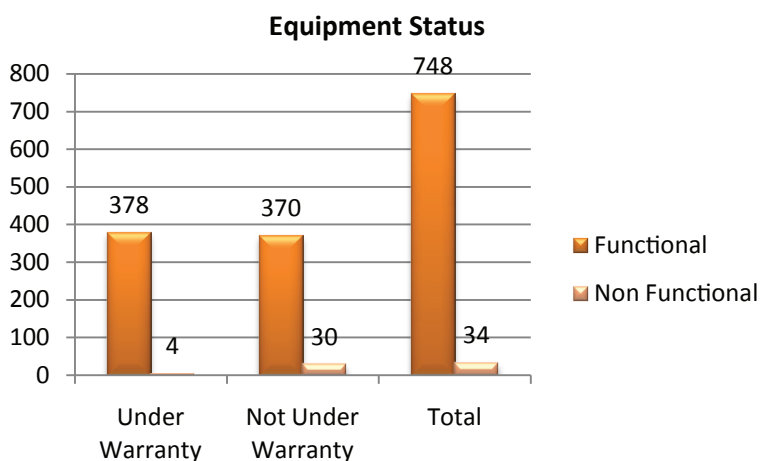
6. Facilitated the observership training program - 2 doctor and 4 Nurses went to KEM, Mumbai for receiving the training.
