

## **Terms of Reference**

### **Medical Officers of SNCU**

1. Will be exclusively dedicated for SNCU.
2. Responsible for the routine monitoring of SNCU.
3. Clinical decision making strictly under the protocol and guidance of PGMOs.
4. Responsible for documentation of all neonates.
5. Have to monitor the inventory within the unit.
6. Consult with the PG MOs for final decision.
7. Have to attend the labour call whenever required.
8. Responsible for post natal rounds of all new born delivered in district facility whenever required.
9. Have to attend the two days NSSK (Navjat Shishu Suraksha Karyakram) training after joining.
10. Twelve hours night shift for 10 days every month followed by 1 day off.
